First a note from the editors ...

church and I bought into a church system of consumerism. I thought I knew what church was supposed to look like only to realize in my late 30s that I had missed it. It took me almost 30 years to figure out that church was *not* all about attendance, or *consumerism*. My view of what church was supposed to be was so far off, I was absolutely mortified when I took a look at what God's Word has to say about what a church should look like. That growing a church was the responsibility of each member. We, in America have gotten so far away from the Biblical example of church, Satan has done a masterful job of making us ineffective. How exactly has he done this? Simple, by making church about us instead of God. Consumerism!

Let me begin by stressing, I do not believe all churches in America are bad or wrong and I don't believe this church is perfect, but let me say this. This church, like many others out there, strives to do it Biblically. The Bible is our standard and nothing else.

Now, I want you to know that this church usually does not do *topical* sermons. We teach expositionaly through the word, one verse at a time. We take a book of the Bible and move through it verse by verse,

That's where an elder board comes in but we'll get into that later.

The burn out rate of pastors is about 5 years because of the misinformed congregations across the country who believe that the pastor is supposed to be all things to all people.

For now, I want to openly recognize that this church is not perfect, I am not perfect. Because this church reflects my strengths and weaknesses, I want to expose those strengths and build on them, and expose our weaknesses and fix them.
