WHO TO CONNECT WITH?

PROFESSIONAL SERVICES The Apostle's Feet Ministry is designed to help the members of Whispering Pines Church with a focus on widows. The following passages are the primary scriptures used to guide the ministry.

Acts 2:42And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. 43And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. 44And all who believed were together and had all things in common. 45 And they were selling their possessions and belongings and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. 46And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, 47 praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.

Acts 4: 32Now the full number of those who believed were of one heart and soul, and no one said that any of the things that belonged to him was his own, but they had everything in common. 33And with great power the apostles were giving their testimony to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus, and great grace was upon them all. 34There was not a needy person among them, for as many as were owners of lands or houses sold them and brought the proceeds of what was sold 35 and laid it at the apostles' feet, and it was distributed to each as any had need. 36Thus Joseph, who was also called by the apostles Barnabas (which means

son of encouragement), a Levite, a native of Cyprus, <u>37</u> sold a field that belonged to him and brought the money and laid it at the apostles' feet.

Acts 6: 1 Now in these days when the disciples were increasing in number, a complaint by the Hellenists arose against the Hebrews because their widows were being neglected in the daily distribution. 2And the twelve summoned the full number of the disciples and said, "It is not right that we should give up preaching the word of God to serve tables. 3Therefore, brothers, pick out from among you seven men of good repute, full of the Spirit and of wisdom, whom we will appoint to this duty. 4But we will devote ourselves to prayer and to the ministry of the word." 5And what they said pleased the whole gathering, and they chose Stephen, a man full of faith and of the Holy Spirit, and Philip, and Prochorus, and Nicanor, and Timon, and Parmenas, and Nicolaus, a proselyte of Antioch. 6These they set before the apostles, and they prayed and laid their hands on them.

As we looked at these scriptures several things became clear:

- 1. These scriptures address the needs in the local body.
- 2. The believers were devoting themselves to the fellowship, studying the word, and prayer.
- 3. The need of clothing and food were being met by those in the body that were moved by God to sell their possessions and

belongings to meet the needs in the body.

4. The management of the distribution process was turned over to a group of men which allowed the Apostles to focus on teaching God's word.

With this model in focus at Whispering Pines Church:

- 1. We limit the Apostle's Feet Ministry to members in good standing.
- 2. Our primary concern is the spiritual health of our members. Our desire is that the member be actively involved in Bible study, and fellowship.
- 3. We ask the member to fill out a Request Form so the need can be given to the ministry team for prayer and consideration. Knowing and communicating the exact need is more difficult than in the church in Acts that met daily and could see that a person lacked clothing or food.
- We have a team which prays for. and makes recommendations as to how to handle the need.
- 5. In the cases of a financial need, our desire is to help with short and long-term solutions by assisting with budgets and

financial suggestions. These suggestions come mostly from "Crown Ministries".

With the following scriptures in mind the ministry encourages the members of body to be Spirit led and act according to God's guidance.

James 2: 14What good is it, my brothers, if someone says he has faith but does not have works? Can that faith save him? 15If a brother or sister is poorly clothed and lacking in daily food, 16and one of you says to them, "Go in peace, be warmed and filled," without giving them the things needed for the body, what good is that? 17So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead.

The beautiful thing in Whispering Pines Church is you don't have to go long before you notice that when there is a need, someone is stepping up to fill it. From providing meals, to trimming trees, there are many members serving each other. Maybe you have wondered how you can serve. In time, we are going to have a location on the website where you will be able to list any of your skills you would like to share with the body.

We also want to avoid getting in the way of God's call to believers to care for their family as seen in the scripture below. But there may

be times that the family cannot help family, so when completing the request it is important to clarify the circumstances.

1 Timothy 5: 3Honor widows who are truly widows. 4But if a widow has children or grandchildren, let them first learn to show godliness to their own household and to make some return to their parents, for this is pleasing in the sight of God. 5She who is truly a widow, left all alone, has set her hope on God and continues in supplications and prayers night and day, 6but she who is selfindulgent is dead even while she lives. 7Command these things as well, so that they may be without reproach. 8But if anyone does not provide for his relatives, and especially for members of his household, he has denied the faith and is worse than an unbeliever.

Hopefully this gives some insight to the Apostle's Feet Ministry. Our desire is to serve the body. If you find yourself or family in need, please let us know. There are forms in the office in the mail boxes on the right-hand side, or ask one of the pastors and we would be happy to get you one. When you complete the request it can be returned to a pastor or placed in the offering box. Upon receipt, the team leader will put the request to the ministry team and normally contact you within the week.
