Pastor's Corner – Freedom Galatians From Pastor Dan

It is around the 4th of July that we start thinking of the freedom and liberty that we enjoy. Upon closer inspection we realize there is much more to our freedom and liberty than waving a flag and eating hot dogs. Look at Isaiah 61:1-2. It tells of someone who came to proclaim liberty to the captives and opening the prison to those who are bound. This "someone" is Jesus. The "Good News" is freedom and liberty that comes through Him during this time of the God's favor.

The Jews had a problem during Paul's time. You could accept the message of the gospel, but you also had to earn your freedom by practicing some of the requirements of Judaism. Paul noted the threat to liberty by those who wanted to define what it really meant. Galatians 2:4-5 reminds us that the fight for our liberty in Christ requires constant vigilance. How do we maintain this vigilance? Let's look at Galatians 5:1. Jesus came to set us free! We are to stand firm in His freedom and not slip back again into that prison of sin. Don't use this freedom as an excuse to sin. Don't start thinking in terms of what I want and need, think in terms of how can I love the other guy, and what he needs. If I love my neighbor as myself, it helps take the focus off of me. What happens if I fall back into sin? Go to I John 1:9 and remind yourself what the Word says about confession and forgiveness.

Look at the difference between the freedom in Christ and the slavery that comes from following what the flesh wants. Compare the works of the flesh in Galatians 5:19-21 and the fruit of the Spirit in Galatians 5:22-23. Big difference between slavery and freedom! Live as servants of God.

His last MRI (at 5 months) showed his right optic nerve is underdeveloped, and thinning in the midline structure of his brain. We waited anxiously while they completed the MRI and then for an appointment with the neurologist. We found out that his brain is fully developed and there are NO deformities of his brain. His optic nerve is still just as under developed as it was when he was 5 months old so he's still blind in his right eye, which we didn't expect to change. He has officially "graduated" from neurology, endocrinology, and hematology. He has NO developmental delays and is thriving.

The biggest weight has been lifted off our shoulders and this little man will no longer have to be poked and prodded at. He has been a trooper through it all!
