Jesus commands of us. If we do that, then God has 'promised' us that He will be with us always, to the end of the age.

If we don't read and study them, all of the epistles, we have no idea what they say and we tend to, as God puts it, "Do what seems right in our own eyes." Always a bad idea.

We're going to first tackle the main problems with "the church" in America so you can see how the American Christian church as a whole has drifted from scripture. Again, not all churches have drifted but by far MOST of them have. Over the next few articles we're going to dissect those issues, bring us back to scripture, then we're going to embark on a journey to make this church even more healthy than it is now, more complete, more effective, more energized and we're going to be effective servants to be used by the Holy Spirit to save souls in Nevada County and elsewhere.

This is going to take dedication by every person in this congregation. It will take dedication and faith but don't forget that Jesus told us to consider the cost of following Him because the only thing He asks in return for redemption is *everything*. If you are not serious about wanting to become the church Jesus has asked us to be, I'm telling you this is not the church for you.

Ok, so let's get started.

We live in a culture of consumerism. Everything that we do is becoming more and more about us 'buying' something. Our home, work, entertainment, travel, everything is more about being served than serving. We are being conditioned to be "spectators."

- We want to be served
- We want to be entertained
- We want it to be easy and convenient

The church has also conformed and bought into this concept. It has become a "seller" just like corporations. In fact, no area of society is immune to it. The world and its methodologies have swept into all fads, movements and religions. They are all effected by this culture of consumerism.

The one true church has also bought into this culture of consumerism. There's less and less interaction. We feel that we are participating because we're all watching the screen behind the pastor. We are too busy enjoying the show and not building relationships with our Church Family. We want media instead of commitment. We have traded "trust and obey" with "watch and consume". We love anonymity and we're naturally lazy. We are

more interested in joining an audience instead of a body. We watch and observe worship but don't participate. Instead of being in the world but not "of" the world, we are now "in" the world and "in" the church.

Anyone who takes an honest look at scripture, particularly Acts 2 and the early church, would have to look at the Christian church in America and say, "What has happened?" How have we moved so far away from the standard? The standard that God has set for us.

We have to start with the standard, God's standard. We must begin with the Biblical model of church. What is the Biblical model of church? Amazingly enough, it's in your Bibles. Please take a minute and read Acts chapter 2, beginning in verse 42 and reading through to verse 47 (below), this is Luke's description of the early church and he describes the church this way:

⁴² And they devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and the fellowship, to the breaking of bread and the prayers. ⁴³ And awe came upon every soul, and many wonders and signs were being done through the apostles. ⁴⁴ and all who believed were together and had all things in common. ⁴⁵ And they were selling their possessions and belongings

and distributing the proceeds to all, as any had need. ⁴⁶ And day by day, attending the temple together and breaking bread in their homes, they received their food with glad and generous hearts, ⁴⁷ praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to their number day by day those who were being saved.

Ok, so we have a lot in these few verses and we're going to be taking a close look at this and other scriptures that teach us how to build the church. The whole time we study these scriptures I want you to be constantly comparing the Biblical account from these passages of the church to what you're used to seeing in churches in America. See if anything might need to change.

Today we took Colton (our 2-yr. old grandson) to get another MRI of his brain. His last MRI (at 5 months) showed his right optic nerve is underdeveloped, and thinning in the midline structure of his brain. We waited anxiously while they completed the MRI and then for an appointment with the neurologist. We found out that his brain is fully developed and there are NO deformities of his brain. His optic nerve is still just as under developed as it was when he was 5 months old so he's still blind in his right eye, which we didn't expect to change. He has officially "graduated" from neurology, endocrinology, and hematology. He has NO developmental delays and is thriving.

The biggest weight has been lifted off our shoulders and this little man will no longer have to be poked and prodded at. He has been a trooper through it all!
